



How do I setup a mobile hotspot on my phone?

To set up a mobile hotspot, follow these steps:

- **Android:**

1. Turn off the Wi-Fi on the phone
2. Plug the phone into a power source if possible
3. Open **Settings**
Note: Some phones may feature a **Mobile Hotspot** or **4G Hotspot** app. If so, use that instead.
4. Locate the **Wireless & Networks** section
5. Tap **More** underneath, then choose **Tethering & Portable Hotspot**
6. Tap the checkbox for **Portable Wi-Fi Hotspot** or **Mobile Hotspot**
Note: If the hotspot doesn't activate or the item is disabled, your phone may be incapable of creating a Wi-Fi hotspot or that feature may be unavailable under your carrier's data subscription plan.
7. Choose **Set Up Wi-Fi Hotspot** to give the hotspot a different name and assign a password if desired
8. Tap **Save** or **OK** to set your changes
9. You should now be able to locate the hotspot on your computer

- **iOS:**

1. Turn off the Wi-Fi on the phone
2. Plug the phone into a power source if possible
3. Open **Settings**
4. Tap **Cellular** or **Settings**
5. Tap **Personal Hotspot**
6. Slide the slider for **Allow Others to Join**
Note: If the hotspot doesn't activate, that feature may be unavailable under your carrier's data subscription plan.
7. You should now be able to locate the hotspot on your computer
